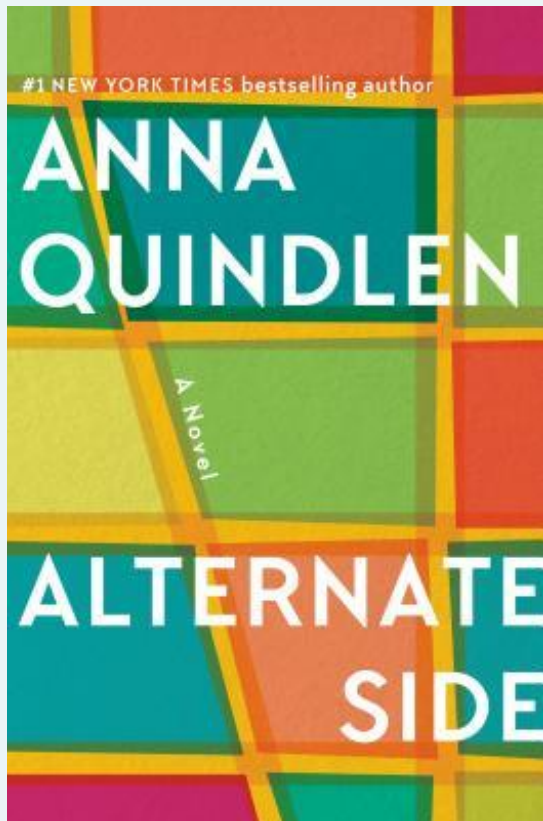

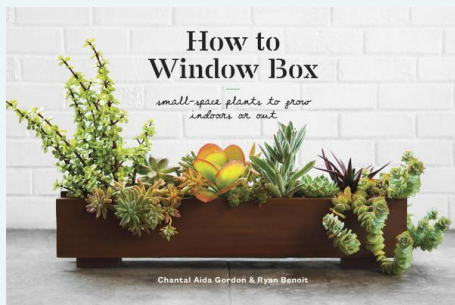
- [Forged in Blood: How the Iron Brigade Earned its Metallic Monkier](#): *Monday, April 9th at 6:00pm*

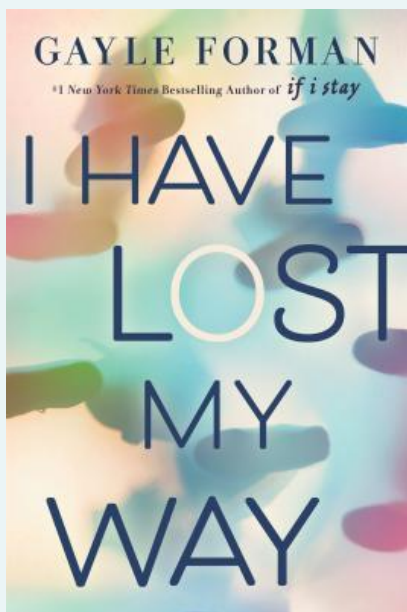
