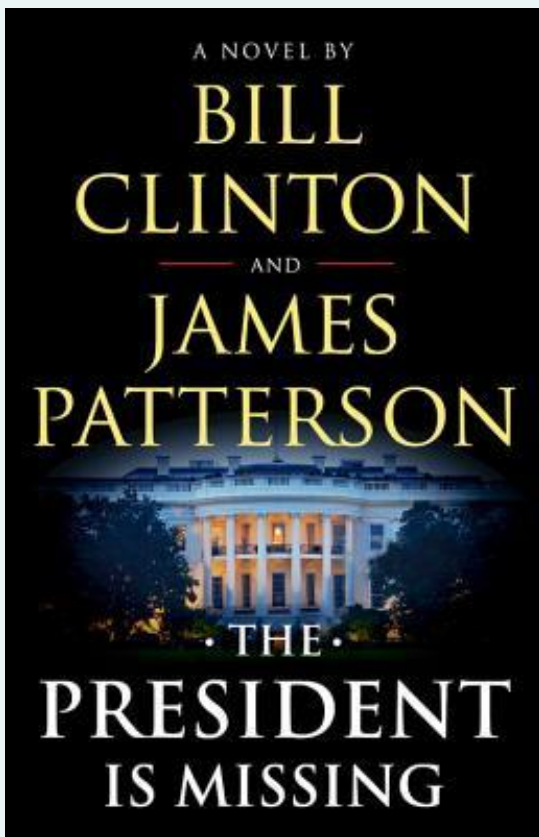

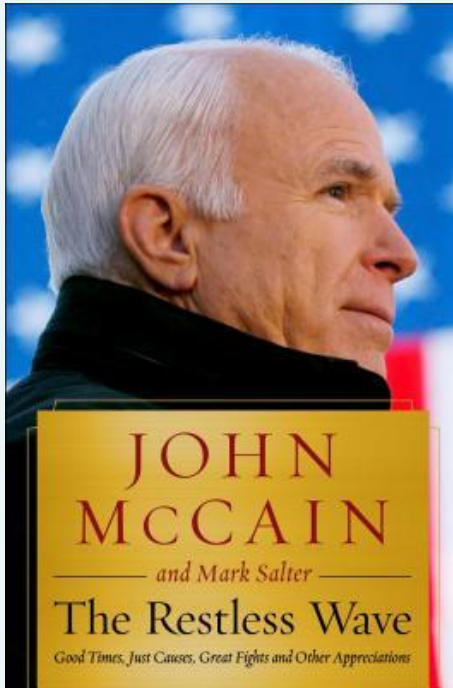

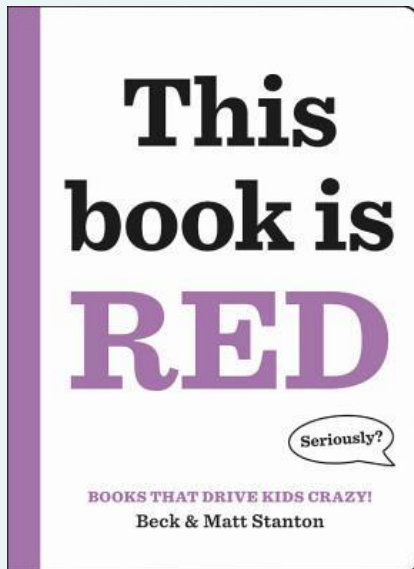
June Programs

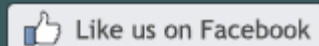
