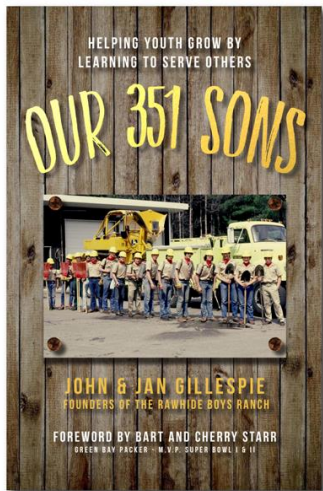
## Adult Department

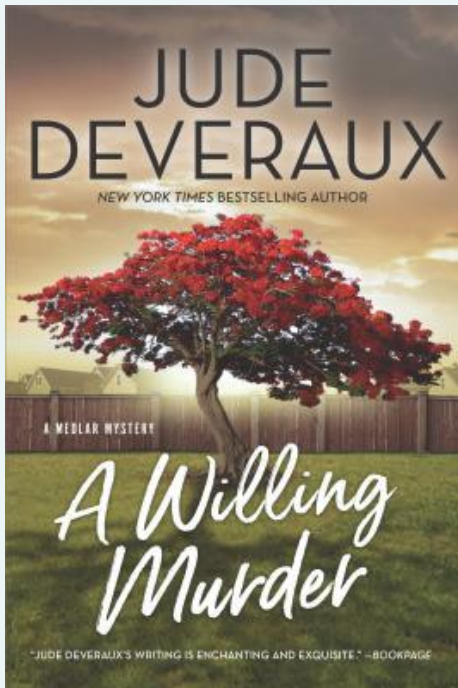

  - This month is all about fish. Check out all the fishy things happening at the library.

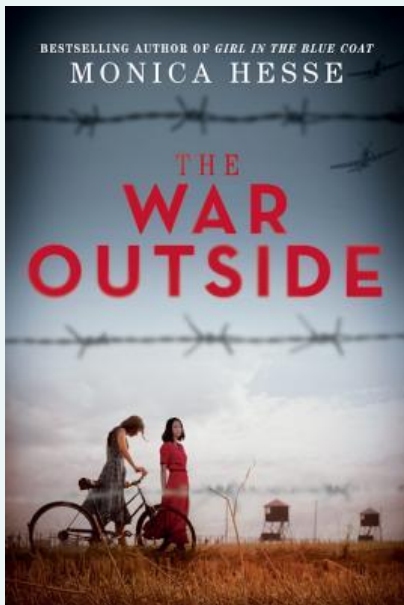
