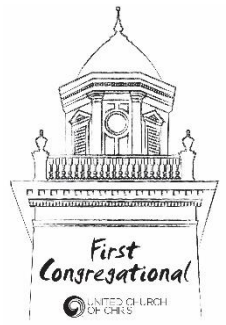




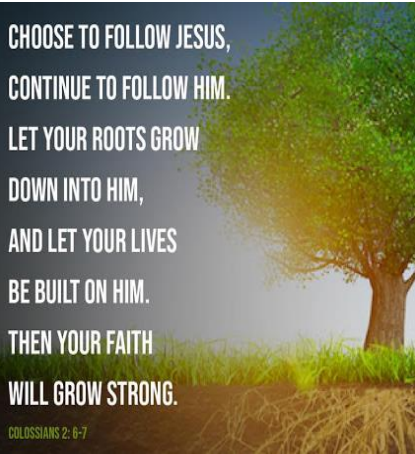

Journeying With Jeannie



Dear Members and Friends,

In the last few weeks, I have had the opportunity to listen to several people talk about their faith journey. It is always interesting to me when someone opens up and talks about their spiritual journey, because no two people have the same story, and every story is important.

I believe sometimes when we think about our spiritual journey's, we don't imagine they are all that special. We can reflect about those in the Bible, like Paul, who on the road to Damascus, had a conversion experience, (You can find this story in Acts 9:4-9) and we want to compare ourselves, but most have never had such an experience.

share the concerns and fears you may have as a church, and they will share the hopes and dreams you also have.

Our job, as members of First Congregational, is to keep our Search Committee members in our daily prayers. But not only should we pray for our Search Committee, but we should also keep in our prayers, the person who will be your next called pastor. This is a very critical time for both First Congregational New London, and your next pastor.

It may seem to some, that our spiritual journey is at a standstill during this pandemic, however, we are still going forward. We are seeking God's guidance and we are looking to the future. During the time I have spent with you, I have come to believe that God has great plans for this church, and I hope you know this to be true also.

As we continue on our spiritual journey, may we continue to look to God for guidance during this time of searching and continue to grow this church as well as in our own spiritual lives.

It has been a while since we have talked about Stephen's Ministry! The pandemic has left us unable to visit on a one-to-one basis, our care givers have not been able to gather for their supervision meetings, this pandemic has left huge holes in our lives!

I am guessing that some of you are not familiar with Stephen's Ministry. This is a confidential Christian program that is here to help you. Are you feeling the effects of the pandemic? I will admit that staying home, unable to visit with friends and family, unable to even attend church service, unable to live our lives as we normally did has been very difficult. Things maybe loosening up now but there are still things that are hard to deal with. Would you like to talk to someone about your feelings? CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS

Because of your continued support of our Camp Scholarships program, we have awarded scholarships to our 17 youth campers this year!! The total amount awarded is **\$4,253.15!**

This is incredible, considering...

...a year of Covid-19 shut-downs, shut-outs, & shut-ins, the cancellation of UCCI summer camp events, virtual worship services and no in-person gatherings, and the unknowns of all of those factors. Even so, we were still able to hold one fundraising event (Christmas wreath sale!) and add the profits from candy bar sales and aluminum can collections, along with donations from our members, a contribution from the Memorial Endowment Fund, and the yearly distribution from the Gralapp Fund! Per the Camp Scholarship Guidelines, we were also able to help a few families with “10% of funds raised will be solely used to assist families in trauma situations and families in crisis to send their children to camp” and K.I.N.D. Funds.

We look forward to the return to this important and long-standing tradition to help provide scholarships to all campers wishing to experience our UCCI Outdoor Ministry sites. A Prayer Shawl is a wrap made with intention and love for a person who is in need of comfort. It is to provide reassurance, solace, or security to a person who is struggling; a shawl can also be given to those who have experienced a recent loss.

I've had an inquiry, or two, by people who would be interested in using their fiber talent, knitting or crocheting—usually, to make such a gift for someone (many times anonymously) in need of comfort. Would you also like to be one of these people?

This is how you can be involved and help:

- Would you be willing to share your talent for the benefit of another by creating a prayer shawl? Your skill level can be as basic as just wanting to learn how to knit or crochet or you may already be able to complete complex pieces: All are welcome, help is available.
- Do you no longer knit or crochet, but have a “stash” of yarn that you would be willing to share? Obviously, all handmade items are a work of love, but their cost is a hidden factor. (That handknit sweater from Great-aunt Adele probably cost her more than twice what you would have paid for it. And that Aran sweater from Uncle Patrick is worth at least a couple hundred dollars—more if made with special yarn!)
- If you're a person in need of this type of comfort, or you know of someone who would benefit from receiving a shawl, please contact Pastor Jeannie at church, who will pass the request on (anonymously, if you'd like) to the fiber artists!
