### A MESSAGE FROM OUR COUNCIL MODERATOR

On April 11th at the monthly Church Council meeting, the Council took additional steps to move our Church forward. The resignation of Pastor Greg Watling during the pandemic, as well as the necessity for not gathering for a significant portion of the pandemic, has changed our Church. I would argue that it has changed our Church forever. When I agreed to become the Council Moderator upon the resignation of our Interim Pastor, Jeannie Douglas, in August of 2021, it was because of my respect for the people that attend this church, and my respect for all the people that kept this Church going over the past 150 plus years. I did not have this position in my retirement plan when I stopped working on July 31, 2021. And I admit that I initially did not want to devote the time I knew was required to help this Church recover and “start over”. I just wanted the Search Committee to find a new Pastor (so I could start executing my long-time-planned retirement plan). I also knew, probably better than most people because of the job I retired from, that the chances of us finding a new Pastor quickly were not that good.

I have now fully committed to doing this job, and I am excited by the progress we have made over the past few months. It really all started when Jim Williams and I recruited Pastor Kevin to take over the Pulpit Supply for our Church. I don’t need to say too much about Pastor Kevin. It is obvious that his work and personality have touched us all.

Pastor Kevin replaced one of our key needs. A spiritual leader to guide us during worship services. However, we still had many areas that were left hanging since Greg departed. Of course, we didn’t need those things to be handled when we were all at home (and only watched Sunday services on Facebook). But now we are open again, and our members need those services to once again be available. This became very obvious when Barb Peterson went into the hospital during her last days, and her family needed the Church to help with her funeral. We quickly rose to that occasion with the help of Pastor Kevin, Lois Cuff, and several other members. We will now be taking the next logical step, which is to increase the services provided as much as we can under our current circumstances. To that end, we have hired Lois Cuff as the new Church Coordinator. The value this position will provide to our Church is substantial (and of course, Lois will do this as a volunteer because of her love for this Church). In order to increase the number of services we provide; we need someone to coordinate those services and become the contact for any member requesting assistance. The second part is to have individuals that can provide those services.

For many things, Lois will put together teams of our own members to provide help. This really is our new model for starting over, helping each other. But of course, we are not all equipped to provide every service that is needed by our members. That is where Pastor Kevin will step in.

The second action we took at the April Council meeting was to hire Pastor Kevin for additional events and services. Pastor Kevin has agreed to officiate, as requested by our members, for such occasions as weddings, funerals, baptisms, and confirmations. In addition, Pastor Kevin will perform duties like in-home communion, hospital visits and phone calls. However, all of these additional events and services will be set-up and coordinated by our new Church Coordinator, Lois Cuff. Lois will be the contact person for any event or service that a member wants Pastor Kevin to be a part of. We want to be perfectly clear that Pastor Kevin is our contracted employee. He is not employed as our Pastor. He has a full-time job at Cline Hanson Funeral Home, and we do not want to jeopardize that in any way. We are very grateful that Kent Rusch and Cline Hanson have allowed our Church to utilize his talents to serve our church, as we continue to search for a new Pastor. Please reach out to me if you have any questions or concerns regarding the new actions the Council has put into motion.

## UCC COUNCIL MINUTES – APRIL 11, 2022

Council Members Present: Tina Clegg, Dave Thiel, Dorea Lauer, Jerry Schulz, Jamie Darkow, Jim Williams, Kaylene Kloehn-Pluger; Members & Friends Present: Katelyn Schmidt, Lois Cuff, Billy Brandt, Wally Schmidt, Pastor Kevin Dembinski

1. Call to order at 6:04 PM
2. Opening Prayer by Rev. Kevin Dembinski
3. Minutes from March 14, 2022, were reviewed. Motion to approve by Kaylene, seconded by Tina. Unanimous Approval.
4. Bell Choir Director position had one applicant, Billy Brandt. Motion to hire Billy Brandt by Jerry and seconded by Kaylene. Unanimous Approval.
5. Choir Director Brandt reviewed and outlined the Music program for the remainder of 2022. Choir and Bells will be active. However, the May festival of music will be moved out until next year.
6. The newly developed position of Church Coordinator was discussed. Lois Cuff has volunteered to fill that position and submitted an outline of the programs and action teams she will develop in the coming months. Motion to approve Lois Cuff as the Church Coordinator by Kaylene, seconded by Tina. Unanimous Approval.
7. The Role of Rev. Kevin Dembinski as Pulpit Supply Minister was reviewed and suggestions as to how his role may be increased were discussed. Pastor Kevin has agreed to increase the amount of services he is contracted to perform, including weddings, funerals, baptisms, and confirmations. However, all of the preparation for these services will be coordinated by our new Church Coordinator, Lois Cuff. In addition, Pastor Kevin will perform duties like in-home communion, hospital visits and phone calls. Again, all activities will be organized by the Church Coordinator. We are very grateful that Pastor Kevin and Cline Hanson have allowed our church to utilize his talents to serve our church, as we continue to search for a new Pastor. A motion was made by Jerry and seconded by Dave to contract with Rev. Kevin Dembinski for additional services. Unanimous Approval.
8. Restarting our Confirmation classes was discussed. Lois Cuff, Tina Clegg and Katelyn Schmidt will form an action team to develop a Confirmation Class curriculum, as well as a plan on how to staff the program with volunteers and mentors.
9. Building Maintenance issues were discussed, and follow-up will occur via the Church Coordinator.
10. The Membership Letter and Postcard data was discussed. Of the 208 letters that were sent, 59 cards have been returned. We are anticipating that many more will be turned in before the deadline of April 24. We need this crucial data so we can fairly represent the size of our congregation to any Pastors that will be submitting their resumes to our church, as well as to the UCC WI Conference. In addition, we need this data for internal planning for everything from budgeting to educational programming.
11. The UCC WI Conference Annual Meeting will be attended by Lois Cuff and Mary Schulz.
12. The Financial reports were reviewed with no questions. Operations Ministry reported that the repairs to the exterior of the building are still in need of some work with minor bell tower leaks, drainage pipe positioning, and tuck point issues. With just a few tiles yet to be installed, the contracted roof repair has been completed. Worship Ministry discussed Sunday's attendance figures of 97, the largest number of attendees since we reopened for in-person services. A discussion regarding the future of our online presence ensued. Ways to enhance the online experience will be part of future discussions.
13. After discussion of the Church's Annual Financial Audit, a motion was made by Dorea and seconded by Dave to approve the audit form and Ad Hoc Committee that will conduct the audit (Milt Staskel, Rita Thiel, Lois Cuff). Unanimous Approval.
14. New Business - None.
15. Closed Session - None
16. Motion to adjourn by Tina, seconded by Kaylene. Meeting adjourned at 7:25.
