## Projects include but are not limited to...

#### Garbage Removal

Perform street sweeping and trash removal for the Downtown area.

#### **Gutter and Curb Detailing**

Keeping gutters and curbs clear of trash, leaves and debris.

#### Park Beautification

Groups can be regularly assigned to specified parks and public spaces to keep them vibrant. Pulling weeds, painting or wiping down amenities.

#### **Graffiti Removal**

Groups can be trained to remove graffiti on public property.

<u>Specialized Clean-Focused Initiatives</u>
